NARCOTIC DRUGS AND PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCES (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE) ORDER 2009

The Administrator makes the following Order in exercise of the powers under section 3(2) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006(a).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Amendment of Schedule) Order 2009 and comes into force on the day it is published in the Gazette.

Amendment to the First Schedule (Controlled Drugs) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006

2. Paragraph 1 of Part II (Class B Drugs) of the First Schedule to the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006 is amended—

- (a) by inserting “1-Benzylpiperazine (BZP)” after “Amphetamine”;
- (b) by repealing “Levomethamfetamine” and replacing it with “Levomethamfetamine”
- (c) by inserting “m-Chlorophenyl-piperazine (m-CPP)” after “Levomethamfetamine”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the Order)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Amendment of Schedule) Order 2009. It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Order. It does not form part of the Order.
2. The Order amends the list of Class B drugs in the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006 by adding the substances 1-Benzylpiperazine (BZP) and m-Chlorophenyl-piperazine to the list of Class B drugs in paragraph 1 of Part II of the First Schedule to the Ordinance.

POLICE ORDINANCE (SNAKE ROAD CLOSURE)(No. 2) ORDER 2009

The Chief Constable makes the following Order under section 24(1) of the Police Ordinance 2007(a).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Police Ordinance (Snake Road Closure)(No. 2) Order 2009 and comes into force at 0800 on 7 December 2009.

Closure

2. (1) All vehicles are prohibited from using the road between the Waterloo Road West roundabout and the junction of the Larnaca to Famagusta main road with the Pyla to Pergamos road in the Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area during the times specified in paragraph (2).

(2) The times specified are from 0800 to 1700 daily.

Expiry of Order

3. This Order ceases to be in force at 1700 on 16 December 2009.
